WHAT'S ON

HOW TO GET THERE

BY CAR:

Address: Great Tew Park, Great Tew, Oxfordshire, OX7 4AF

- **From Oxford**, follow the A44 through Woodstock, and after a few miles turn right onto the B4022 at Enstone
- **From Banbury and the Midlands**, take the A361 south from Banbury towards Chipping Norton, turning left onto the B4022 towards Enstone and The Tews
- **From the South-West**, get to Burford using the A40 or A361, then follow the A361 north to Chipping Norton, then turn right onto the A44 towards Oxford and left onto the B4022 at Enstone towards The Tews
- **From the West**, get to Chipping Norton on the A44 or A361, then follow the A44 towards Oxford and turn left onto the B4022 at Enstone towards The Tews

Please follow signs and use the appropriate entrance. Onsite parking is free.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

By Train: Great Tew Park is about 30 minutes' drive from Banbury Station (serviced by Chiltern Railways) and around 12 minutes from Charlbury Station (serviced by Great Western).

By Bus: There is a festival shuttle bus available from Banbury and Charlbury Stations. Please see our website for further information and timings.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

DAY & WEEKEND TICKET HOLDERS (ie. those NOT camping):

- **ALL STANDARD DAY OR WEEKEND (NON-CAMPING) TICKET HOLDERS** should follow signs for the **ORANGE GATE**, then follow the directions of the stewards for parking and the arena entrance.
- **ALL VIP DAY OR WEEKEND (NON-CAMPING) TICKET HOLDERS** should **clearly display their GREEN car sticker on the windscreen of their car** and follow signs for the **GREEN GATE**, then follow the directions of our stewards for the VIP Day Parking.

ALL CAMPING TICKET HOLDERS (including VIP):

- **QUIETER CAMPING TICKET HOLDERS** should enter the site via the **ORANGE GATE**, then follow the directions of the stewards for Quieter Campsite Parking.
- **GENERAL CAMPING TICKET HOLDERS** should follow signs for the **RED GATE**, then follow the directions of the stewards for Main Campsite Parking.
- **ALL CAMPERVAN PERMIT HOLDERS** will receive a separate email with specific instructions.
- **GLAMPERS** should **clearly display their BLUE sticker on the windscreen of their car** (this will be sent to you separately before the festival, by the supplier you have booked your Glamping through) and follow signs to the **GREEN GATE**, then drive onto **Glamping Parking in the Walled Garden**.

CAMPERVAN PERMIT HOLDERS (including VIP):

- **CAMPERVAN PERMIT HOLDERS** should **clearly display their PURPLE Campervan Permit sticker on the windscreen of their campervan or caravan** and enter the site via the **PURPLE GATE**, then follow the directions from the stewards for Campervan parking.
- **Please note**, instead of creating a new field, we have extended the original Ledwell Lane Campervan Field. This means **EVERYONE** (whether you purchased a 'Ledwell Lane' or an 'Other Campervan Field' pass) will receive the same **PURPLE** pass and should follow signs to the **PURPLE GATE**.

PLEASE NOTE:

On arrival at the event your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband. Weekend ticket holders will be issued with one wristband, which must be worn for the whole weekend. **PLEASE DO NOT TAKE YOUR WRISTBAND OFF UNTIL YOU ARE SURE YOU WILL NOT BE RETURNING TO THE SITE.**

All children aged 16 or under must be accompanied onto the site by an adult, and proof of age may be required on entry for all concession ticket holders.

SECURITY:

In light of recent events, we've undertaken a full review of our security measures at Cornbury Festival. Public safety remains the top priority for us and additional security will be in place over the weekend. Please expect increased bag searches and security in the car parks and at the gates.

We ask for the patience and cooperation of anyone coming to the event on the weekend and that they allow extra time to pass through security.

ENTERING THE ARENA:

- **BAGS & BELONGINGS:** In order to make your entry to the ARENA as easy and quick as possible, please only bring small bags and essential items. Large bags and items are likely to cause delays.

- **CHAIRS:** Due to the extra security checks and the fact we are expecting the site to be very busy this year, we strongly encourage you not to bring chairs into the arena. Anything that is deemed too 'bulky' will not be allowed into the arena, so please consider this before entering. You are welcome to bring rugs and some seating will be available on site.
- **WIND BREAKS OR TENTS:** we will not be allowing any wind breaks or tents into the arena.
- Please consider this advice before packing, as our lovely stewards and security team will ask you to return large chairs, wind breaks and tents to your cars or campsite as you enter the arena.
- NO professional recording or photographic equipment will be permitted.
- NO food or drink (except baby food and 500ml plastic bottles of water) can be brought into the arena. Of course you're welcome to bring your own food & drink into the car parks and campsites.

CAMPING ARRANGEMENTS

Once you have parked your car, your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband according to which campsite you purchased your tickets for. Please then follow the directions of our stewards to the correct campsite:

The Main Campsite where the Campsite Bar is located.

The Quieter Campsite which is likely to be the quieter area suitable for families with small children.

Glamping which contains pre-paid Tipis, Podpads, Cloudhouses, Bowtop Caravans, Lovely Campervans, Tangerine Tents and The Pop Up Hotel.

For your own safety please respect the trees within Great Tew Park and do not camp or sit under the trees.

WHEN YOU RECEIVE YOUR TICKETS:

Please check your tickets carefully, as mistakes cannot always be rectified. Keep tickets in a safe place. Please note that direct sunlight, heat or water can sometimes damage tickets. Lost, stolen, damaged, destroyed or undelivered tickets cannot be replaced or refunded; there will be no admission without a valid ticket. Tickets cannot be transferred, re-sold, refunded or re-issued, or they will become void and the ticket holder may be refused entry or ejected from the Site. Tickets are sold subject to the Promoter's right to alter or vary the performances and/or the Festival due to events or circumstances beyond its control, without being obliged to refund monies or exchange tickets.
