OPENING TIMES:

The Campsite closes at Midday on Monday 16th July.

WHAT'S ON:

Music will commence at approximately 11am each day on at least one of the stages and will conclude at approximately 11pm each day on the main stages.

A detailed Festival Running Order and Site Map will be published in the Festival Programme only available to purchase on site.

HOW TO GET THERE:

BY CAR: Great Tew Park, Great Tew, Oxfordshire, OX7 4AF

- **From Oxford**, follow the A44 through Woodstock, and after a few miles turn right onto the B4022 at Enstone.
- **From Banbury and the Midlands**, take the A361 South from Banbury towards Chipping Norton, turn left onto the B4022 towards Enstone and The Tews.
- **From the South-West**, head to Burford using the A40 or A361 then follow the A361 North to Chipping Norton. Turn right onto the A44 towards Oxford then left onto the B4022 at Enstone towards The Tews.
- **From the West**, head to Chipping Norton on the A44 or A361 then follow the A44 towards Oxford. Turn left onto the B4022 at Enstone and The Tews.

Please follow signs and use the appropriate entrance.

Parking on site is free.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

- By Train:** A very restricted service will be running on Thursday 12th, Friday 13th and Monday 16th July. **NO** Service will be running on Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th July. (Great Tew Park is about 30 minutes' drive from Banbury Station - serviced by Chiltern Railways and approximately 12 minutes from Charlbury Station - serviced by Great Western).
- By Bus:** Due to the scheduled engineering works in the Oxfordshire area, we will not be running a shuttle bus services this year from and to Charlbury Station and Banbury Station.
- By Coach:** **NEW** There will be a Big Green Coach service departing from London Victoria and Oxford on Thursday 12th July and returning to Oxford and London Victoria on Monday 16th July **ONLY**. Tickets and times can be found at www.biggreencoach.co.uk
- By Taxi:** 001 Taxi's **01865 240 000** will be on site providing taxi services throughout the weekend.
- By Car Share:** Alternatively, a cheap, social and sustainable way to travel is to car share. Spaces and availability can be found at www.gocarshare.com/festival/cornbury

ON ARRIVAL:

DAY & WEEKEND TICKET HOLDERS (NOT Camping):

- **ALL STANDARD DAY OR WEEKEND (NON-CAMPING) TICKET HOLDERS** should follow signs for **ORANGE GATE**, then follow directions of the Stewards for Parking and Arena Entrance.
- **ALL VIP DAY AND VIP WEEKEND TICKET HOLDERS (NON-CAMPING)** should clearly display their **BLUE Car Sticker on the windscreen of their car** and follow signs for **GREEN GATE**, then follow directions of the Stewards for VIP Parking.

CAMPING TICKET HOLDERS (ALL including VIP):

- **QUIETER CAMPING TICKET HOLDERS** should enter the site via **ORANGE GATE**, then follow directions of the Stewards for Quieter Campsite Parking.
- **GENERAL CAMPING TICKET HOLDERS** should enter the site via **RED GATE**, then follow the directions of the Stewards for Main Campsite Parking.
- **CAMPERVAN PERMIT HOLDERS (Regular and Oversized Campervan including VIP)** Should clearly display their **YELLOW** sticker on the windscreen of their vehicle and enter the site via **PURPLE GATE**, then follow the directions of the Stewards for Campervan Parking.
- **GLAMPERS WITH A RED STICKER** should clearly display their **RED** sticker on the windscreen of their car and enter the site via **GREEN GATE**, then follow the directions of the Stewards for Glamping Parking.
- **GLAMPERS WITH AN ORANGE STICKER** should clearly display their **ORANGE** sticker on the windscreen of their car then enter the site via **ORANGE GATE**, then follow the directions of the Stewards for Glamping Parking.
- **ACCESSIBLE PERMIT HOLDERS (Accessible Parking and Accessible Camping)** should clearly display their **BLUE** sticker on the windscreen of their vehicle and enter the site via **GREEN GATE**, then follow the directions of the Stewards for Accessible Parking.
- **NB: WEEKEND CAMPING WITH VIP** - Parking in The Main Campsite and Quieter Campsite Parking is closer to both Campsites than VIP Car Parking and therefore more inconvenient for yourself.

VEHICLE PERMITS AND PASSES:

Regular Campervan Permits and VIP Day & Weekend Car Passes (Non Camping) will be sent together with your tickets direct from Eventim.

Oversized Campervan & Accessible Permits will be sent direct by Emma Cope from The Cornbury Festival Office.

Glamping Car Passes will be sent direct from the relevant Glamping Company you have purchased from.

PLEASE NOTE:

On arrival at the event your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband. **Weekend** ticket holders will be issued with one wristband, which must be worn for the whole weekend.

PLEASE DO NOT TAKE YOUR WRISTBAND OFF UNTIL YOU ARE SURE YOU WILL NOT BE RETURNING TO THE SITE.

All children aged 16 or under must be accompanied onto site by an adult.

Proof of age may be required on entry for all concession ticket holders.

SECURITY:

Public safety remains a top priority for us. We ask for your patience and cooperation, and to allow additional time to pass through security and bag searches.

ENTERING THE ARENA:

- **BAGS & BELONGINGS:** In order to make your entry to the Arena as easy and quick as possible, please only bring small bags and essential items. Large bags and items are likely to cause delays – no bag will mean no queuing.
- **CHAIRS:** Anything that is deemed too 'bulky' will not be allowed into the Arena, so please consider this before entering. You are welcome to bring rugs and small chairs.
- **WIND BREAKS OR TENTS:** We do not allow any wind breaks or tents into the Arena.
- **NO professional recording or photographic equipment will be permitted.**
- **NO food or drink** can be brought into the Arena (except baby food and 500ml plastic bottles of water). Of course, you are welcome to bring your own food & drink into the Car Parks and Campsites.
- Please consider this advice before packing, as our lovely Stewards and Security Team will ask you to return large chairs, wind breaks and tents to your cars or campsite as you enter the Arena.

CAMPING ARRANGEMENTS:

Please follow the directions of our Stewards to the correct Campsite. Once you have parked your vehicle, your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband according to which Campsite you purchased your tickets for.

The Main Campsite where the Campsite Bar is located.

The Quieter Campsite which is likely to be a quieter area suitable for families with small children.

There are **TWO** Pre-Paid Glamping Areas this year.

Glamping in the Arboretum:

Podpads, Tangerine Fields, Cloudhouses – Yurts & Sqrts, Gregs Gypsy Bowtops, Lovely Campervans, Love Your Tent, and The Canvas Co.

Glamping in the new location via Orange Gate:

Pop Up Hotel, Eve's Tipis and Airstream Facilities.

For your own safety please respect the trees within Great Tew Park and do not camp or sit under the trees.

TICKETS:

Please check your tickets carefully as mistakes cannot always be rectified and there will be no admission without a valid ticket.

Keep tickets in a safe place.

Please note that direct sunlight, heat or water can sometimes damage tickets.

Lost, stolen, damaged, destroyed or undelivered tickets cannot be replaced or refunded.

Tickets cannot be transferred, re-sold, refunded or re-issued as they will become void and the ticket holder may be refused entry or ejected from the Site.

Tickets are sold subject to the Promoter's right to alter or vary the performances and/or the Festival due to events or circumstances beyond its control, without being obliged to refund monies or exchange tickets.
